

237 & 238 : Therefore, whatever is manifested is the supreme Brahman Itself - Real, non-dual, extremely pure, the essence of Knowledge Absolute, taintless, supremely peaceful, without beginning or end, beyond all activity, always of the nature of Bliss Absolute, transcending all diversities created by maya, eternal, the essence of joy, indivisible, immeasurable, formless, unmanifest, nameless, immutable and self effulgent.
